Catterick Garrison Sailing Club (CGSC) is based at Thornton Steward Reservoir. CGSC has group membership of Thornton Steward Sailing Club, who hold the water access lease from Yorkshire Water. CGSC is an RYA Accredited Training Centre and can offer Youth Sailing, National Sailing Scheme and Powerboat Courses. CGSC does not have any permanent staff so specific training is based on instructor availability, though we do run Youth courses during the summer holidays.

We have 6 dinghies at the Reservoir, 3 Fusion, 2 Laser 2K and a Laser Stratos, more are available if required. Membership of CGSC is open to serving and retired military personnel, MOD civilians and the families of those serving in the Garrison. Unit membership of CGSC gives units access to the reservoir on weekdays, family and individual membership gives access every day of the week. There is normally a member of the CGSC Committee at the Reservoir on a Wednesday afternoon.
